

NOTICE TO ALL PARENTS OF CHILDREN IN MINOR SPORTS IN THE CORNWALL AREA

The Town of Cornwall is very proud of the top notch facilities they have in the community. The recent completion of the second phase of the Terry Fox Complex has this project costing over five million dollars. In our efforts to be fiscally responsible to all tax payers in the Town we have moved towards a user pay system to help offset operational costs of its facilities. This is similar to other municipalities. As a result of this the Town of Cornwall has been working with minor sport organizations to try and seek out ways it can support these volunteer organizations with the rising costs of implementing their programs.

This year the Town has provided the Cornwall Area Minor Ball Association, Eliot River Ramblers Soccer Association and the Timberwolves Football Club an opportunity to generate funds in the following ways;

- 1) To sell sponsorship signboards at the Terry Fox Complex this potentially could generate \$ 10,000.00 to each organization if they sell 20 signboards each.
- 2) To donate all sales off the canteen for one weekend per calendar year (after expenses) to each of the organizations.
- 3) Coordinate a weekly 50 / 50 draw where funds are split between the organizations.
- 4) The Town also provides administrative support to the various organizations including processing registrations, notices in community newsletters and office space for meetings.
- 5) Also when required the Town has assisted the Associations with seasonal field preparations, field upgrades, general maintenance and equipment for the Associations for day to day operations and special events.

The Town works hard to ensure they make as much effort as possible to support the groups in our Town. We appreciate the hard work and endless hours that all our volunteers do for the residents of our community!
